

This along with prior knowledge of permanent makeup led to research about different esthetician and permanent makeup schools.

I have never been in a class that intrigued me so much. After countless hours of learning, I not only learned permanent makeup but also took skin rejuvenation classes of Korean BB GLOW. This treatment was amazing, as it used needles but brought no pain. The instant glow on the face by injecting the serums into the skin using a needle pen



was incredible. I didn't know at that time that these trendsetter services would become a part of my career.

Finally, I was blessed to find a wonderful lady, Wendy Ly who is a permanent makeup artist and instructor in Omaha.
